NEW BUSINESS:

1. Appoint new Interim City Manager.

Mayor Sasser spoke of having called a Special Meeting to appoint an Interim City Manager and admonished everyone that only discussion could be about the topic that the meeting was specifically called for.

Commissioner Babb mentioned that the City Attorney had spoken to him and stepped forward, volunteering to work a couple of days a week, although it was not budgeted, due to the fact that they did not have a City Manager. He further suggested that if the City Attorney was appointed as Interim City Manager, she could appoint someone in her place when she was not actually on the property.

Vice-Mayor Crawford said that he discussed with her that if she was at City Hall two or three days a week that would be fine. The City Attorney does not have to be there every day, the City Clerk can sit in her place the days that she is not there to handle the day to day administrative operation of the City. Mr. Cobb can keep the Roads and Streets Department, running as smoothly as possible.

Mayor Sasser said that he'd spoken with the City Attorney and he felt she would be perfect for the job.

A motion was made by Commissioner Babb and Seconded by Vice Mayor Crawford to appoint the City Attorney as the Interim City Manager. The motion passed unanimously.
