Kevin Lyttle (Soca)

Kevin Lyttle (born **Lescott Kevin Lyttle Coombs**, 14 September 1976) is a soca artist hailing from Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, who had a worldwide hit with the interpellative soca ballad "Turn Me On", which was recorded by Lyttle and the dancehall artist Spragga Benz. His strong live performances of soca influenced by dancehall and contemporary R&B made the song a hit throughout the Caribbean.

It was officially released as a single in the UK in late 2003 and reached number two in its first week, spending seven weeks in the Top 10 of the UK Singles Chart. It later reached number eleven in Finland and number three in Australia; and was a hit in other twelve countries. The single was released in the U.S. in 2004 and the video was added to MTV on 24 May 2004. "Turn Me On" eventually went gold in the U.S. and peaked at number four on the Billboard Hot 100.

Lyttle signed with Atlantic Records in 2003. His self-titled album was released in 2004 in the U.S. The second single, "Last Drop", has been released in markets outside the U.S., and has reached the Top 10 in Finland, the Top 20 in Switzerland, the Top 30 in the UK and Top 40 in the Netherlands, Sweden, and Australia. Lyttle's latest album, *Fyah*, was released by Universal Records in Japan in the late summer of 2008. It featured contributions from the artists, Problem Child, Lexus and Skinny Fabulous, a duet version of "Turn Me On" with Alison Hinds, and the Kevin Rudolf produced Something About You, written by Rudolf, Lyttle and Larry Nacht¹U.S., Canadian, European and Caribbean releases followed.

Silk (R&B)

R&B Sensation, Silk are best known for their hit singles, "Happy Days", "Freak Me" from their debut album, *Lose Control*. Another hit from *Lose Control*, "Girl U For Me", helped the album reach double platinum status. They later had success with singles such as "I Can Go Deep", "Hooked On You", "Don't Rush", "If You" (released February 23, 1999) "Meeting In My Bedroom", and "We're Calling You."

Silk was discovered by the musician Keith Sweat. In 2003, Silk released their fifth album *Silktime*, on their own label Silk Music Group. The album featured the songs "Silktime", "My Girl", "Alibi", "More", "You (The Baby Song)", "Check My Story" and a cover version of Blue Magic's "Sideshow". In 2006, the group returned with their sixth release, a cover album entitled *Always and Forever* on Shanachie Records. The album featured covers of R&B songs including "Adore" by Prince, "Always and Forever" by Heatwave, and "Secret Garden" by Quincy Jones. "Secret Garden" was the first and only single.

The People UpStairs (TPUS) have quickly become well known across South Florida as THE quality local act with a sound audiences immediately connect with. TPUS combine modern rock-funk with a groovy island touch and Latin rhythm to bridge barriers and broaden appeal. After hundreds, of live shows and distributing thousands of demo CD's, the diversity of their fans has been proven to span all races and ages. The ensemble includes vocals, bass guitar, lead guitar, drum set, and a plethora of auxiliary percussion. Each member has been playing music since at least the 6th grade with many receiving extensive formal training. TPUS are in demand all over Florida for their crowd-pleasing live performances. The band has traveled to Florida State's Tallahassee, the University of Florida's Gainesville, and the University of South Florida's Tampa at the venues' request (and expense) to have TPUS entertain their college-town audiences. At home in South Florida, TPUS have become advertised regulars in several venues with establishments competing

to book the band on high-traffic nights. TPUS performed at Sunfest in 2009, supporting Damian Marley, 311, Slightly Stupid and Pepper. TPUS also performed a Military New Years Eve bash on Andros Island in the Bahamas. TPUS released their debut album in 2005, Synchronfunkinicty, under Hoot Recordings. Their second full length album entitled "For the People, By the People" features all new material and is set to be the best recoding of the bands existence.
